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Questions and Responses:

1. We have done a quick review of subject RFR and have a couple of critical questions. The criteria seem very restrictive. They imply that a candidate must have already worked for the State in a similar role based on their experience and knowledge required in many areas of the State's policies/procedures, operations and standards. Has any contractor previously done similar work for the State and if so when?

A: The requirements for this RFR have been updated per Amendment #1.

2. Also the State is asking for an SME that has deployed large-scale CCTV surveillance and monitoring systems and experience in the design and implementation of a large scale technical project in a State or Federal Agency. Can you please clarify how a person with these type of skills would also be familiar with CATS and writing RFP's, IFB's and TORFP's? It seems like these would be two different people and skill sets with the latter being a contracts or procurement type person.

A: We feel that SMEs exist with this background based on other projects that have been completed by other State agencies. The skill sets needed are technical in nature, which is the root core of this procurement. The SME will only be assisting with writing the Scope of Work for an RFR, TORFP or IFB, if one is needed.

3. Is this a new position or incumbent?

A: This is a new procurement.

4. Is this a replacement system or new installation?

A: This is what the awardee is to determine.

5. Are floor plans and drawings for the installation site available?

A: Yes, floor plans and drawings are available, however will only be shared with the Awardee who will be required to sign a Confidentiality Agreement prior to viewing them.

6. Can we schedule a site walkthrough?

A: Yes. See above information regarding the site visit.
