Background

The Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) exemplifies energetic leadership and innovative products and services to improve public education, library services, and rehabilitation services. The Agency has received a Race to the Top grant from the US Department of Education to implement educational reforms in Maryland and improve the collection and dissemination of information on school and student performance.

Several MSDE Race to the Top initiatives will implement new technology systems, train end-users on how to use them, and improve access and information provided by MSDE reporting information systems. Race to the Top educational improvement initiatives will also engage researchers, policy-makers, program managers, superintendents, administrators, teachers, and the public in MSDE’s improvement efforts. The purpose of this Request for Resume is to acquire the short-term services of a **Systems Design Architect for the Division of Accountability, Assessment, and Data Systems (DAADS)** to research, design, and implement the enterprise networking infrastructures, along with the definition of engineering requirements necessary for configuring Development, Testing, Staging, and Production environments for systems/applications deployed under the Race To The Top grant. Network and infrastructure analysis may include, but is not limited to the sizing of enterprise servers and bandwidth; analysis of network topologies; recommendation of enterprise hardware, operating systems and supporting software. Supporting software may include monitoring tools and other enterprise support network applications.

Also, the candidate must:

1. Demonstrate all aspects of proper communication skills, both verbal and non-verbal.
2. Articulate clear and concise responses to the interview questions.
3. Possess good interpersonal communication skills and proper attire.
